

Some thoughts.....

I'm sure you were horrified like me when you saw the pictures and listened to the reports from Israel last weekend. To see the bodies of young and old lying where they had been murdered; to feel the fear of men women and children -hostages - being dragged away to an uncertain future; to listen to the despair of those who have lost friends and loved ones; was truly heart-breaking. And was it any easier to look at the smoking remains of buildings in Gaza after Israeli missiles targeted Hamas bases but inevitably took the lives of civilians including women and children, old and young? As members of the human race I'm sure we all felt the same and maybe even remembered Burns' words from his dirge 'Man was made to mourn.' (which I must admit I had never read) 'Man's inhumanity to man

Makes countless thousands mourn!'

But as Christians, how do we react to what's happening in the 'Holy Land' today? There are Christians on both sides of the divide, Jewish Christians, Palestinian Christians – as Paul puts it in Galatians 3:28 – 'There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.' We see right and wrong on both sides of this conflict – Hamas is a terrorist organisation using whatever definition you would use; Israel has a right to survival but has the responsibility of a civilised nation to do their utmost to protect non-combatants. How can it be solved? I'm not sure it can be completely until Christ comes back but until then we pray - we pray for peace and justice, we pray that Jew and Palestinian would turn to recognise Jesus as the Messiah in whom

all are one, brothers & sisters together.

<u>Enjoying God in Prayer – 2.</u>

This week we continue the series looking at prayer. My thanks to Kieran, the Pastor at Dedridge Baptist Church for allowing me to share this.

3. We enjoy God by meditating on his person

No one who has read the bible or the lives of past saints can fail to notice the place meditation has in helping us to enjoy satisfaction in God. Not only does Moses instruct Joshua to meditate on God's word day and night but David prays asking that the meditation of his heart be pleasing in Gods sight. He could only ask this - because he meditated.

Some say meditation is a lost art. If it is, I would say it's because today we live life in the fast-lane. You cannot meditate if your living life at speed. If we are driving on a fast motorway, our eyes need to be on the road ahead. If we are driving slowly, say, in the country, we can look around us a little, and enjoy the scenery. Today we live life on the motorway, only interested in what's ahead, and are the poorer for it.

Meditation, if you allow me to press the driving analogy, happens when we pull into a lay-by and concentrate, not on where we're going, but who is with us, and that of course, is God. To get to know him better, like David, in Ps1.1-3, we will listen to what he has to say. We will dwell for a while on a word, sentence, verse, or paragraph God has used; reflecting on what it tells us of God and only then, on ourselves and circumstances. We may have a small notebook, just to record what is said. David did this. Going back to the lay-by we might decide to look out the car window, at scenery. David did: Ps 77, 'I will consider all your works and meditate on all your mighty deeds.' Maybe in the distance we spot a church; it's there to tell the world about God's Love. We might meditate on that; David did. Ps.48.9, 'In the midst of your temple, O Lord, we meditate on your unfailing love.

But the point is, in slowing down, and listening, we learn to enjoy God's presence. We get to know him, not just as the subject of a manual, but the One who is with us. Bona: 'the sweetness of God's presence.'


So many of us ask God to change the circumstances to suit our desires, instead of us conforming to His will. Don't let circumstances distress you.

It was just two months ago that we emailed you with a reflection that in this broken world, disaster is never far away. Sadly, when we did so, we had no idea quite how true that statement would be. With news of the escalating conflict between Israel and Hamas this week, and reports of two deadly earthquakes in Afghanistan (see more below), your prayers for these tragedies could not be more crucial

Following the surprise Hamas attacks on Israel last Saturday and the subsequent counterattack and siege of Gaza, our partners in Israel-Palestine have asked you to lift up the following in prayer.

From Bethlehem Bible College in Palestine:

• Pray that God's love and peace may transcend the divisions and hatred that have plagued this region for so long. Pray also for God to help us all to be instruments of his peace, promoting justice, understanding, reconciliation, and most importantly a just peace in the Holy Land.

• Pray for leaders and decision-makers, that they may be inspired by wisdom, compassion, and a desire for peace.

• Lift up the families and individuals affected by the conflict, those who have lost loved ones, homes, and livelihoods.

• Pray for the Church in Gaza, that it will be salt and light to its communities during these difficult days.

From the Association of Baptist Churches in Israel:

• Pray and affirm that God is sovereign over the entire universe and has the power to change this situation. Pray that there will be a swift end to the conflict and that it does not escalate into a larger war in the region.

• Pray for those who are grieving the loss of their loved ones. Pray too for those who've been wounded during the conflict and for those providing medical assistance to them. Pray that God's strength and peace will be with those affected.

• Pray for wisdom and discernment for leaders, that they would make decisions that lead to lasting peace and alleviate suffering. Pray for peace and security for the entire region, and that the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its wings.

Psalm 46: 1 says "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble". Please keep praying that an end to this conflict will be seen soon. And if you want to do even more to make a difference when crises occur across the globe, please consider giving to our <u>disaster recovery fund</u> today.
