Today is the 11<sup>th</sup> day of the 11<sup>th</sup> month, a day which this nation and others have set aside to remember those who gave their lives in armed conflict, serving their country. At 11.00am on 11<sup>th</sup> November 1918 the Armistice to end the fighting in the First World War came into effect and every year since there has been a 2mn silence to remember.... and as Christians we share in that remembrance. 

Many doctors now believe that among the contributing causes of the common cold are stress, tension, and inner conflict.


Paul must have been in the midst of such a personal civil war when he cried "oh wretched man, than I am. Who will deliver me? From this body of death?"

And then he gives the wonderful answer to his own question when he said:


"I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord!"
