

BMS Prayer Guide 2024

In many parts of the world, girls and women are denied access to education, employment, land, property, finances, status and respect. All too often, they are victims of violence. But the value Jesus placed on women was radically counter-cultural. BMS World Mission is committed to promoting the idea that women are inherently valuable, made in the image of God. SUNDAY 31



Pray that gender equality becomes the air we breathe. Lift up BMS partners as they contextualise the BMS Gender Charter. Pray that they will be open to considering their own gender theology to help overcome the fractures in society.

MONDAY 1

Astha Shrestha works with Human Development and Community Services (HDCS), BMS' partner in Nepal. Pray for Astha as she promotes maternal and child health, encourages educational attainment for girls, and implements empowerment projects for women and girls.

TUESDAY 2

Celebrate individuals with special needs who add value to our communities, remembering their intrinsic worth. Pray for the centre for children with learning differences run by the Lebanese Society for Education and Social Development (LSESD) now known as Thimar (see p19).

WEDNESDAY 3

KISC EQUIP, BMS' partner in Nepal, is introducing safeguarding and gender-based violence training for teachers. Lift up their work towards reducing child abuse and improving girls' attendance and retention in schools.

THURSDAY 4

Ask God for wisdom for Justice Livelihoods Health (JLH), BMS' partner in Uganda. Pray that their interventions will reduce inequalities and ensure justice for both females and males.


FRIDAY 5

Pray for BMS partners supporting refugees and asylum seekers. Women are often the most vulnerable, frequently facing injustice and inequality not only in their context of origin but also in their new location.

SATURDAY 6

Praise God for gender champions and BMS partners who have embraced women in leadership. May their efforts help free girls and women from gender-based violence.

<u>A Thought from Charlie</u>

"We have one who speaks to the Father in our defence – Jesus Christ, the Righteous one." (1 John 2:1)

An advocate is a person who pleads for another's cause. But Jesus, our Advocate, adds a twist: He pleads his own cause, and he does so to our advantage.

For instance, picture a throne room with the devil reading a list of charges against you. He throws you an accusing glance and sneers: "This wretch deserves to die. He says he is a Christian but his life stinks. He claims to know Jesus, but you've never been able to tell from the way he acts".

Now Picture Jesus standing as your advocate. He speaks confidently and with authority saying: "this person is mine. I died for every sin he ever committed". That would be enough, but then Christ adds something. Even more amazing: "What's more, I've not only erased his debt, but I want you, Father, to credit to his account all of my righteousness".

Jesus, our advocate, would be generous enough in cancelling the debt of our sin on the Cross...but he went further. He not only paid the penalty and cleared sins slate, he gave us right standing, His goodness. When the Father looks at you, he sees all the good things his son has ever done.

Such a debt we can never repay. We can only praise. "Even now my witness is in heaven, My advocate is on high. My intercessor is my friend as my eyes pour out tears to God: On behalf of a man he pleads with God as a man pleads with his friends." (Job 16:19-21).

- 2. Those close to you friends, family, church.
- 3. Folk who are having particular problems just now such as long-term illness, which is defying the medics, family relationship breakdowns, crisis of faith, loneliness. Folk who are hiding things going on in their lives.
- 4. Those in our country suffering with mental health issues, those living on the bread line, struggling to pay their bills, those suffering addiction problems, or unemployment.
- 5. The folk who live around you the folk you meet in the community as you are shopping, walking the dog or whatever.
- 6. Our local politicians and councillors, our Scottish parliament and the MSPs of every party. The government in Westminster and the issues they are grappling with.
- 7. The ongoing situation in Ukraine where people are still dying daily. Death and destruction with no end in sight.
- 8. The war in Israel/Gaza. Pray for wisdom for those who have influence. Pray for a just peace which allows people of good will to live side by side in friendship. Pray for a removal of the extremists on both sides. Pray that God, in his goodness, will intervene to bring an end to the hate. Pray for the Christians living in Gaza and Israel that they might be influential in spreading the good news of the gospel which recognises neither Jew nor Palestinian, male nor female rich nor poor but all as sinners needing the love and forgiveness which knowing Jesus brings.

Father, as I look forward to another week help me to live for you, to tell those I meet about your love for them, and honour you in everything I do. In Jesus' name, Amen
