

Birthdays are special times and when you're young it seems to be ages between one birthday and the next but, of course, as we get older that time gap seems to shrink and we think — 'It can't have been a year can it?' Well this weekend we celebrate 79 years of Broxburn Baptist Church witnessing to the community in which God has placed us. Quite a number still in membership can recall many of these years but there are none of the original members who signed the statement of intent left. But those of us who are here are the inheritors of the legacy left by those gone before.



On the front cover of this and many previous newsletters is the thought that 'Church is



not something you go to, it's a family you belong to' and that is true of this church. The family comprises folk who are here every Sunday, folk who are a bit more irregular, those who call Family Fellowship their church, the mums and grannies (and dads) who bring their kids to The Lighthouse, the kids themselves and their older siblings who come to Level Up, the visitors who pop in when they're in the area, the folk who contact the church looking for help with food or finance, those who come to Coffee&Chat, the ladies

who meet monthly, the folks who come and lead our services and there may be some I've missed out. But not all members of the family are Christians by conviction. Some don't believe in God, others are of different faiths – or none. Some come for friendship and others because they feel they should and there are other reasons – and that's OK because we want them to hear about God's love and feel the warmth of being part of a Christian community and we want them to see Jesus and come to know for themselves the feeling of sins forgiven and a future assured. Also, not all the Christians who are part of the family are church members. As a Baptist church we believe that the Bible teaches

that those who become Christians should witness to the change in their lives by being baptised as a believer. As we celebrate tomorrow as a family where are you? Maybe this weekend could be the time when you take that first step of faith and give your life to Jesus – or maybe this is the time you commit to membership by asking about baptism. Bangladesh

Life in Bangladesh has stabilised after last year's uprising, but the country is still in an interim phase. Amidst uncertainty about the future, the Church remains faithful to its calling.



Praise God that Christians in Bangladesh can depend on the Lord in times of uncertainty.

SUNDAY 5 Pray for political co-operation so that Bangladesh can hold free and world
fair elections. Pray for transitions of power towards a just and peaceful future for all people groups in Bangladesh.
MONDAY 6 Many Christian women are experiencing discrimination. Pray that women will experience freedom and healing through new trauma and empowerment workshops run by BMS World Mission's partner the Bangladesh Baptist Church Sangha (BBCS).
TUESDAY 7 Pray for trainees at BBCS' mission training centre who are planting churches in new fields. Pray that groups of new believers will be established and protected in each place.
WEDNESDAY 8 Pray for wisdom for BMS workers Louise and Peter Lynch as they support BBCS to find the best way to train evangelists, pastors and church leaders.
THURSDAY 9 Pray that John Karmakar, BBCS General Secretary, will have protection and wisdom as he leads during this time of national uncertainty. Pray that Molina Karmaker, Director of BBCS' SHED board, will find solutions to the resourcing challenges they face.
FRIDAY 10 Pray for the faculty at the Christian College of Theology Bangladesh. Pray for Pastor Jyoti as she returns from overseas study and pray for wisdom for the college Principal, Wailes Rangsa.
SATURDAY 11 Pray that all the resources necessary to support newly-trained mission workers and pastors will be provided, and that BBCS will have capacity to sustain this vital training.

A - ADORE


C - CONFESS


